2. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

- Unintentional ingestion of large quantities: do not induce vomiting. If appropriate, consult a Poison Control Centre or doctor.
- Skin irritation: consult a doctor.
- Massive inhalation: move the person to fresh air. If discomfort persists, consult a poison control centre or doctor.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

Flammable product.

In case of fire, use carbon dioxide for small fires, water spray or foam for larger fires. Use special protective equipment: gloves, protective eyewear, gas mask, etc.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Eliminate any source of ignition or open flame from the affected area. Stop leaks and ventilate the area if this is not dangerous. In case of massive leaks, alert the fire department. - Avoid mixing with other or similar products or with different substances not foreseen in the specific instructions.
